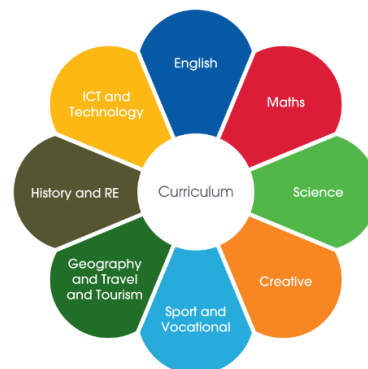

Please come and join the fun at the Harvest Market, on the school field, 11:00am-2:00pm. The bouncy castle will be raising funds for our school.



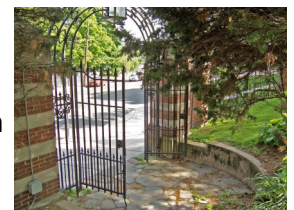
Story-time
