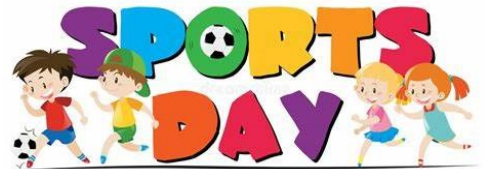

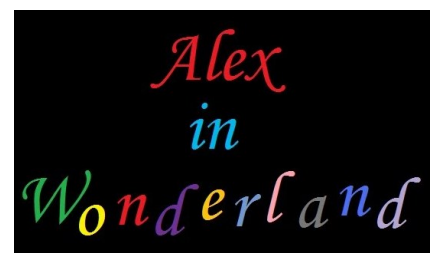
Alex in Wonderland
