Week 3	9am – 1pm	Monday 12 th - Friday 16 th (With Lunch)

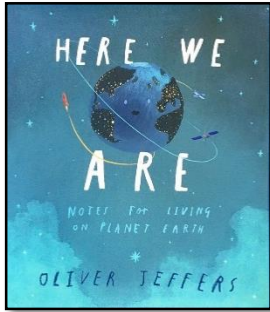
