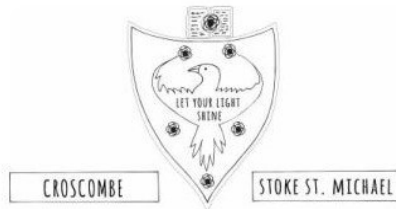

A special thank you goes to Peter Barkwill, CEO of Wainwrights who officially open the event and then stayed on to chat with the stall holders, children and parents.



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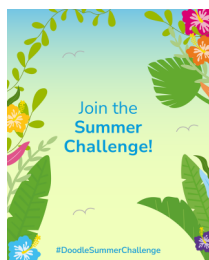
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### Nut Allergy Aware Federation

### 40 For The Federation 2022

- **14 Mile Live Route 24th September** - starting and ending at Stoke School (age 16+)
- **26 Mile Live Route 24th September** - starting and ending at Stoke School but also passing through Croscombe School (age 16+)
- **26 Mile Virtual Route 1st-26th September** - Walk 26 miles over 26 days (open to all ages)



The Live events are £40 per person to enter. The Virtual event is £20 for an individual adult or £40 for a family (1 adult & 2 children).
