

Mastering Number Year 2 Parents Workshop

Our federation has been involved with the Mastering Number project and training. It aims to secure firm foundations in the development of good number sense for all children from Nursery and Reception through to Year 1 and Year 2. The aim over time is that children will leave Key Stage 1 (Years 1 & 2) with fluency in calculation and a confidence and flexibility with number. Attention will be given to key knowledge and understanding needed in Reception classes, and progression through Key Stage 1 to support success in the future.

The NCETM Mastering Number web page has a short videos which gives a flavour of Mastering Number happening with different age-groups. The teachers explain how the programme has benefited all pupils their classes, providing firm foundations for later work in maths. Year 2 teachers across the federation Mrs Veevers and Miss Miell have been working together to provide a parent workshop for Year 2 parents. This will be happening in both schools on:

Federation Acorns classes had a great opportunity for to start their weather lessons this term. The children had a practical start to their science lessons this term as we were treated to a very light dusting of snow! The children have been using apparatus to measure different aspects of the weather such as temperature, wind speed, wind direction and rainfall. They have made their own wind sock, rain gauge and weather vane and have experimented with it outside in the breeze whilst learning about compass and wind directions.
