Dear Parents and Carers,

Sun Safety

The British summer is fickle thing but whilst the sun shines please do ensure that you follow this helpful advice from the British Skin Foundation:

- Use a sunscreen with a minimum SPF 50 and at least 4 stars for UVA protection
- Reapply every two hours or immediately after swimming or sweating (children are welcome to bring in to school a named bottle of sunscreen to reapply to themselves at lunch time).
- No sunscreen offers 100% protection so cover up with a wide brimmed hat to protect the neck, ears and face.
- Wear sunglasses, ideally with wrap around lenses or wide arms, which carry CE and British Standard marks.

And of course, please ensure your child has a named water bottle with them everyday as it is vital for health and learning to stay well hydrated.
