National Average 12% SEND Stoke St. Michael – 23% Croscombe – 14% 1 child with Educational Healthcare Plan IJ thanked TM-S for a comprehensive report. TM-S will be involved with Parent's Evenings for certain families, there are allotted timeslots for each child. Parents meetings are ongoing across SSM and Croscombe. Feedback at handover was that parents were aware of their child's SEN needs and plans, however this was not the case and TM-S has been in contact with all parents to go through the plans with them. Target sheets for children enable celebration of achievement. Communication is key. Potential for policy to be that parents are given a copy of their child's plan, currently written from pupils' point of view so in an accessible format, they run alongside a pupil profile. Evidence of impact – how can parents see? Bringing parents on board through meetings and discussion. All plans were in place with clear individual outcomes. These need to be reviewed regularly. 'Phase review' plans (children moving up a key stage) Positive feedback form parents. TM-S will introduce plan to child and parent, class teacher and TA will then work to implement and action.
