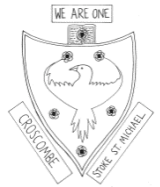

Chestnuts Class - This week in Chestnuts the children have been busy in maths working with money (Year 3) and fractions (Year 4). Year 3 children have been learning to write money using the different notations (£ and p) and using their skills of addition and subtraction to find change. This is a life skill so please ask them to help you in the shops next time you are paying. Year 4 have been finding equivalent and simplest fractions.

In literacy the children have been learning all about 'signposts' in discussions. These are key phrases which help to structure a discursive piece of writing - we have some very interesting conversations about whether unicorns exist or if there really is a pot of gold at the end of the rainbow!
