

Following on from yesterday's email, we are aware that certain aspects of the news surrounding the children returning to school on Monday has understandably caused a heightened sense of concern amongst parents. We have a very committed staff team who always without fail put the children's health and welfare first. We have revisited our covid safety measures and are confident that if there was to be an outbreak it would be controlled and contained. However please be reminded of the following:

Everyone **MUST** ensure your children adhere to **TIER 4** rules when outside of school. This is a parental responsibility and absolute caution is needed here in order to keep our community safe from the virus.

Do not send your children back to school if anyone in your house hold is self-isolating for any reason. Please inform us if this is the case.

Please check your children's temperature on a regular basis. Do not send them into school if they present with a temperature of 37.7 degrees Celsius or above.

Under no circumstances should your child come to school with a cough. Ensure a test happens. Our nearest drive through test point is Warminster. Book online for same day or next day slot.

Please wash and keep uniform, lunch boxes and water bottles clean on a regular basis.

Please wear a mask at all times on approach to and from the school gates.

Make sure you are extremely prompt with drop off and pick up times. Do not allow older children to walk through the gate when it is the slot for the younger children unless they are the older siblings. Drop and leave, do not linger.

3:05 - Acorns

3:10 - Years 3 and 4

3:15 - Years 5 and 6
